Subject: CSO Project

Nappanee has been working for approximately 20 years on its long-term control plan to address sewer overflows into the Berlin Court Ditch. The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) issued an agreed judgement that required Nappanee to address the combined sewers and eliminate sewage discharging directly into the Berlin Court Ditch. Nappanee officials and engineers designed upgrades to address the issues. Nappanee will intercept the current overflows along Berlin Court Ditch and convey the sewage, via a new sewer line located on the north side of the ditch, from Nappanee Street to Miriam Street. We will also add a large storage tank and high-rate treatment facility to our sewage treatment facility to handle the overflow during wet weather events.

The project costs are around \$31,000,000. Nappanee received a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development, that will cover approximately 40% of the cost. Construction on the project started in October of 2016 and is anticipated to be completed by late spring/early summer 2018.
