**December 2, 2019**

The City of Nappanee Common Council met on Monday, December 2, 2019 at 7:00 PM in the Council Chambers of the City Building. Mayor Jenkins called the meeting to order.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:** Jake Dermott made a motion to approve the November 18th, 2019 meeting minutes. Brandie Yoder seconded the motion and it carried, *viva voce*.

**APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE VOUCHERS:** Todd Nunemaker made a motion to approve 2019 APVs totaling \$487,338.05. Brandie Yoder seconded the motion and it carried, *viva voce*.

**REPORTS OF CITY OFFICERS:** Clerk-Treasurer Brown stated the Mediacom price update is in the packet for the Council’s information. Brown then went on to remind the Mayor that we wanted to know if the Council would be available on the 30<sup>th</sup> for a possible meeting.
